Salary

We highly recommend you agree a Gross salary. If you agree a Net salary, you risk your job stability, having proof of income and more.

Tax and National Insurance

Holiday

You are entitled to a minimum statutory holiday entitlement based on how many days/hours you work per week. Nannies employed full-time get 28 days of paid annual leave. Use our Nanny Holiday Calculator to work out yours.

Pension
