Here's a fun, step-by-step guide to making snowman crafts using kitchen rolls or loo rolls!

### Assemble with:



Empty kitchen roll or loo roll tubes



Any coloured paper



White, black & orange paint



Paper straws



Glue stick or liquid glue



Any other colour paint you'd like to use (optional)



Small buttons or beads (optional)



Cotton balls or pom-poms (optional, for hat decoration)

Choose your paper colour and set up the paint colours in a tray.

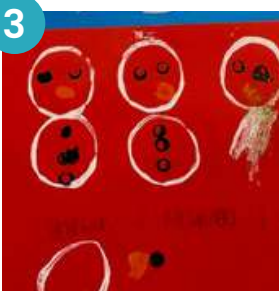
Dip kitchen/loo roll into white paint and stamp onto the paper to create the snowman's body.

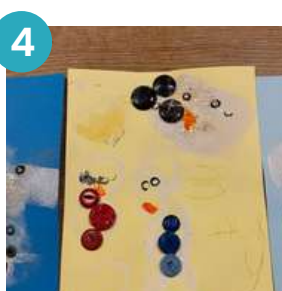
Using your paper straw add the eyes & coal buttons (optional).

Using the other end of your straw, slightly squish the end to create the carrot nose.

Extras to take your snowman to the next level! (Optional)

- Glue buttons or beads down the front instead of paint.
- Create a scarf: cut a thin strip of fabric or coloured paper to make a scarf. Wrap it around the top of the snowman and secure it with glue.
- Make the hat: glue a pom-pom or cotton ball to the top for a fun wintery touch.
- Add arms: cut small sticks or use brown pipe cleaners to create arms.
- Finish with details: add glitter, sequins, or any other decorations to give your snowman extra sparkle!
