## **Sponge Printing Butterflies**

A simple but beautiful craft activity to create some colourful butterflies!

## **Assemble with:**











Sponges

Paint

Elastic bands

Paper



Cut some of the sponges in half and put the elastic band around the middle of the sponge



Put some paint onto both sides of the sponge, this can be done through dipping into the paint, or for older children you could use a paint brush to create a detailed pattern.

You can fold the sponge in half to create a symmetrical pattern, just like a butterfly!



Push the sponge onto the paper and hold down, lift up and repeat, topping up the paint where necessary.



Once dry add eyes, antenna, and any extra details!
